



SOUND CHILDREN'S THERAPY has put preventative measures in place to help contain the spread of COVID-19. However, given the in-person nature of our evaluation and therapy sessions, your risk of contracting COVID-19 may increase.

By consenting to in-person visits, you voluntarily assume all risks and agree that you will not hold Sound Children's Therapy or any of its employees liable for any resulting illness or injury.

To help limit exposure for your child and our employees, we ask that you agree to the following:

- If the client or someone in the client's household is sick or has been sick in the last 14 days with fever, diarrhea, respiratory issues, or sudden loss of taste or smell, you cannot come to the clinic until cleared by a medical professional or confirmed COVID negative.
- Same policy applies to all our employees.
- Employees will take and log their temperature every day before beginning their workday. Anything under 100.4 degrees F is acceptable.
- Clients will have temperature taken at beginning of session in the breezeway. If parent/caregiver participates in the session, parent/caregiver will have their Temp. taken as well. Anything under 100.4 degrees F is acceptable.
- Clients need to wash hands as soon as they enter the clinic. If parents/caregivers are not coming in, clinician will wash client's hands.
- Clinicians will wash hands often but most especially between clients or after sneezing or coughing.
- Clinicians will wipe down /sanitize all equipment and surface areas used between clients. *Sessions may end slightly earlier to facilitate this.*
- Parents/caregivers may not remain in the waiting room. Clinician will greet you and drop your child off in the breezeway. You may use the lobby restroom if needed.

- Clinicians will wear masks or face shields during sessions.
- Children aged 5 and older need to wear a mask unless significant cognitive/mental challenges preclude it. We will provide face shields as an option which will be disinfected between clients. When appropriate for the session, the child may remove the mask but only in the confinement of the therapy room.
- Parents/caregivers need to wear a mask or facial covering if entering the clinic for any reason.
- Parents/caregivers must always maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance while interacting with employees.

Signing this document indicates that you understand the risks and agree to abide by these rules to protect yourself, your child, and the employees of Sound Children's Therapy. Not abiding by or adhering to these rules will prohibit your child to be seen in-person at our facility, and they can be seen online if appropriate via teletherapy. Thank you for your cooperation.
